Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the 2024-25 Budget is delivering record education funding, including \$3.6 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

A project to upgrade Condell Park High School is progressing. The upgrade includes brand new modern facilities in two new buildings and refurbishment across the existing school.

4 shared learning commons



Secure entrance on Third Avenue with
separate public and student entrances



New school hall and canteen
with multipurpose sport court



Refurbishment of Block E including the
expansion of the support learning unit into
7 support classrooms



New staff car park and

The upgrade will also include a major refurbishment of the existing administration block and refurbishment works to Buildings A and C.

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Progress update

- Concept designs and floor plans have been developed for the school upgrade in consultation with the Condell Park High School leadership team. You can see these at the information session on Monday 2 December 2024. Note these are not final and are subject to change as the design and planning approvals progress.
- A Review of Environmental Factors (REF) is being drafted for the planning approval pathway associated with the existing carpark relocation, ahead of the planned wider school upgrade works. More information and a map can be seen below.
- The tender for a contractor to complete the detailed design and construction of the car park and the wider school upgrade works is currently open.

Next steps

- Planning documentation for the wider school upgrade will be finalised and submitted.
- The contract will be awarded and a timeline for completion of all works will be developed with the appointed contractor.

Car Park relocation

The map below shows in red the proposed location and entry to the relocated car park on Third Avenue. The relocated car park has a total of 101 spaces which is an increase in 13 spaces from the existing car park. It is anticipated the work for the new carpark will start in mid 2025.

This is the first part of the upgrade works and will be completed prior to other major works starting to ensure that access to parking is maintained during construction.
