Investing in our schools

As part of the NSW Government's plan to rebuild public education, the NSW Budget is delivering \$3.9 billion for new and upgraded schools in Western Sydney. This targeted investment will ensure growing communities get access to a world class public education.

Project overview

A project to upgrade Condell Park High School is progressing. The upgrade will include new modern facilities in 2 new buildings and refurbishment and landscaping across the existing school. It includes:

- 16 new classrooms with 3 indoor and 3 outdoor learning commons
- new staff spaces including staff study and staff facilities
- new school hall and canteen with multipurpose sport court
- relocated and extended staff car park
- significant refurbishment of the existing administration space including a new secure entrance
- refurbishment of all teaching spaces
- relocation and refurbishment of support learning unit classrooms
- removal of all demountable classrooms

Progress summary

Car park

Work is ongoing on the new car park. We are installing underground services and digging to prepare the ground to the right levels for the car park. Recent rain has slowed down the work, we now expect the car park to be finished in November 2025.

Block E Refurbishment

To prepare for these works we have put up fencing to separate the work area from the school and set up site sheds for the workers.

Next steps

Car park and main construction works

After the car park is finished, the contractor will establish the main work area for the new buildings to be built. This will involve changes to the main school entrance on Third Avenue. These changes are still being finalised, and more information will be shared once they are confirmed. We anticipate this work to begin in late 2025.


Block E Refurbishment

We will begin refurbishment work on Block E, near Townsend Street during the Term 3 school holidays. The work includes:

- **Ground floor:** The science, textiles and performing arts classrooms will get new carpet, furniture, and fresh paint on all walls and doors.
- **First floor:** This area will be redesigned to create a bigger Support Learning Unit (SLU) with 7 classrooms. A ramp will be built to connect the SLU to its own outdoor space. New carpet and paint will also be added to all walls and doors on this floor.

The internal refurbishment to Block E will be complete for Day 1 Term 1 2026. While the internal work is happening, a small number of classes will use temporary classrooms. The external works will be ongoing until June 2026.








Block E Refurbishment works
